ANIMAL LICENSE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Any person within the city limits who owns a dog or cat over 6 months of age is required to obtain a license for their pet. Rabies vaccinations are required at 3 months of age per State Statutes and Municipal Code.

1. Check information and change if necessary. **If rabies vaccinations are past due, enclose certificate with current rabies vaccination date. If your pet has been spayed or neutered, enclose a non-returnable copy of the certificate and make payment changes accordingly.**
2. Municipal Code requires you to notify us if you no longer have your pet.
3. Send appropriate license fees, and late fees if required, in the enclosed pre-addressed envelope. Make checks payable to ANIMAL CONTROL. Please write your driver's license number on your check.
4. Please allow 4 weeks for processing.
5. If your pet has a microchip, write the number next to the pet's name.

LICENSE FEES

The City Council approved license fee increases on April 14, 2003. Funding is continued for the Educational Officer and the Spay/Neuter Grant Program.

LATE FEES

A late fee penalty is required for each animal as follows:

31-60 days after expiration.	\$5
61-90 days after expiration.	\$10
91 days or more after expiration.	\$15

Pet owners shall also be liable for late fees if owner fails to license within 30 days.

License tags are not transferable from one owner or animal to another. Lost tags are replaced at no charge if your pet is currently licensed.

A license fee may be prorated if you wish to consolidate the expiration dates of two or more licensed animals.

Put the tag on your pet's collar!

A rabies tag is not a license. An I.D. tag is not enough. With a license we have your pet's number, and we can locate you if it strays or is injured.
