Our records show that you have one or more dogs or cats that are not current on rabies vaccination or city license as required by city ordinances; 6.12.030 License for Cats, 6.12.020 Rabies vaccination for Cats, 6.08.030 License for Dogs, 6.08.020 Rabies vaccination for Dogs. City ordinance requires that **ALL** dogs and cats six (6) months of age or older, have current rabies vaccination and a city license. There are no exceptions made for indoor or outdoor animals.

Our records show that you have been notified more than once and given ample time to respond. If you do not correct this matter and comply with city ordinance, you will be issued an official court citation and charged a \$25 fine for each animal without a license, a \$25 fine for each animal without a current rabies shot, plus court costs of \$23 per court case. Compare this amount with the total costs of getting your animals current and legal. In the future, fines for violations may be \$50 - \$500 per animal and violation. Please consider this now and avoid higher costs in the future.

Attached you will find a defect ticket. You have until the date listed on the defect to correct this problem or you will be cited by mail for violation of city ordinances and you may have to go to court. If you have any questions you may contact me at 441-7900.
