CLARK COUNTY CODE

10.08.070 Requirement for pet identification

The owner of any dog or cat or ferret shall securely fasten about the neck of the dog or cat or ferret a collar with a tag attached thereto bearing the number of such vaccination or current owner identification tag; or the owner shall have a microchip identification device implanted.

10.12.010 Requirement for rabies vaccination

Every person owning, keeping, harboring or possessing a dog or cat or ferret over the age of three months, within the jurisdiction of the county, shall cause the dog or cat or ferret to be vaccinated with rabies vaccine within thirty days from the date of ownership, keeping, harboring or possessing within the county, or from the date the dog or cat or ferret attains the age of three months, and thereafter continuously maintain rabies vaccination for the dog or cat or ferret.

10.32.010-240 Animal cruelty prohibited

Cruelty or torture means every act of omission or commission whereby unjustifiable physical pain, suffering or death is caused to any animal.

10.36.010 Noisy animals prohibited

It is unlawful for any person to own, keep, harbor or possess any animal which, by loud or frequent habitual barking, yelping, braying or other noise, causes annoyance to the neighborhood or to any person in the vicinity.

10.36.040 Requirement for animals to be restrained and kept in clean conditions.

(A) No person owning or having possession of any animal, shall cause, permit or allow the animal to stray, run or in any manner be at large.

(B) Every person who is the owner of any unsterilized dog or cat, and keeps the same upon his premises under his control, shall keep the animal restrained by a fence, cage, coop, chain, leash or other adequate means so that the unsterilized dog or cat shall not leave or escape from the premises upon which it shall be kept.

(C) No person shall keep any such animal unless its living area is kept clean and free from offensive odors, animal wastes, rodents, flies, or any other offensive or unwholesome conditions.
