Animal Trap Form

A \$40.00 deposit is required on each trap loaned out from the North Richland Hills Animal Services Division, because of the high demand for traps only one per household will be permitted. The deposit is returned to the borrower upon the return of the trap provided the trap is not damaged, normal wear and tear allowed for.

The Animal Services Center being closed on Sunday makes it necessary for you to trip your trap on Saturday and not reset it until Sunday evening, any animal caught will be picked up Monday morning. There is no one available to retrieve animals trapped on the weekends and they must not remain in the trap over the weekend without proper shelter, food and water.

Any animals trapped are to be turned over to the Animal Services Center, it is against the law to dump or otherwise dispose of any animal caught in a trap that is the property of the City of North Richland Hills.

Because of the high demand for the traps you may keep the trap for a period of two (2) weeks from the date it is loaned to you unless, supply permitting, other arrangements are made in advance.
