Suggested Baits

Cat:	Cat food (canned and fish are best)
Dog:	Dog food (canned) or meat bones
Opossum:	Cat food (canned)
Raccoon:	Fish (canned cat food) or corn
Skunk:	Fish (canned cat food) or chicken entrails
Squirrel:	Nuts, peanut butter, bread

The loan of the humane box trap is made possible by you, the city taxpayer. Your tax money is used to purchase the traps, and whenever a trap is not returned, a new one must be obtained at an additional cost to the taxpayers. If you fail to return the trap, we have no choice but to bill you for the cost, minus any deposit which will be forfeited. The cost of the traps are as follows:

Raccoon	\$62.39
Cat	\$44.39
Squirrel	\$28.38

The low cost trap rental program only works when everyone cooperates.
